Welcoming Word from Organisers

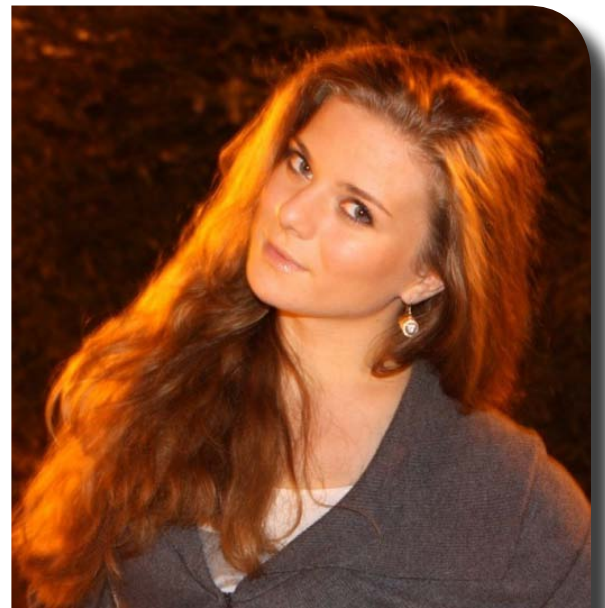
Dear EYPers,

Venues

1) Accommodation

During all 5 session days, participants will stay at the cozy hotel complex «Podillya», which is situated in a picturesque public garden in the city centre. GA and Farewell Party venues are easily reached from this hotel. Comfortable double and triple rooms will be offered to the participants.



2) Committee work

Gymnasium #4 is considered to be one of the best schools in Vinnytsia, and broadly known all over Ukraine as well. Its classes are equipped with all necessary stuff for teambuilding, as well as modern working facilities; and perfectly fit EYP Committee Work activities



3) Eurovillage and Euroconcert

The restaurant, connected to the hotel complex “Podillya” by a spacious functionary hall, consists of a large room for 150 seats, 2 bars (one in the restaurant, the other one - on the 5-th floor of the hotel), 2 banquet rooms with 30 and 15 seats each.



4) Opening Ceremony/General Assembly

OC and GA will be held in Vinnitska Oblasna Rada (Vinnytsia Regional Council) – a place where local regional government is working and gathering for its sessions. It is situated right in the centre of the town, in a 3 minutes walk from the hotel (we will have just to cross the road) and 10 minutes from the Committee Work venue.





Travel Info

Travelling to Ukraine usually is quite easy and not very expensive. Thinking about VinSpring NS, please keep in mind that you will not have need to get to Vinnitsa on your own – the Organisers will meet you in Kyiv and accompany to the city.

How to get to Kyiv?

1. By Plane

There are 2 international airports in Kyiv – “Bo-ryspil” and “Kyiv Zhulyany”. “Zhulyany” is situated within the precincts of a city; and operates with WizzAir low-cost airlines. Due to WizzAir, Kyiv is directly connected to numerous European cities – Barcelona, Hamburg, London, Katowice, Venice and others. Check: <http://wizzair.com>

No matter to which airport you will arrive, Organisers will meet you and accompany to your place or straight to Vinnitsa.

2. By Train

Kyiv is extremely easily reached by train from the neighbouring countries – Russia, Belarus, Poland, Hungary and Slovakia. Check your national operators for exact information.

3. By Bus

If you are from Russia, Belarus, Poland, Hungary, Slovakia, Czech Republic, Latvia, Lithuania or Estonia keep in mind that the cheapest way to get to Kyiv for is by bus.
